Counselors and administration are alerted if students search for certain keywords related to self-harm or suicide. We want to remind students to be mindful of what they are searching for on their chromebooks. Counselors will be speaking with all students on **Thursday the 10th** and **Tuesday the 15th** to go over district protocol for risk assessments, and to also teach appropriate ways to reach out for help for self-harm and thoughts of suicide.

<u>Counselor Meet & Greet</u>- One of our counseling goals this school year is to connect with each and every student here on campus at some point throughout the year. Counselors will call in a few students each day to help achieve this goal. By sitting with each student one-on-one we will be able to develop a better connection with our students, help them set goals and support their overall well being.
